STAR 3/4/5 & Competitive 2017-2018 REGISTRATION IMPORTANT NOTES

1. *Star 3/4/5 & Competitive skaters that fall in this category are divided into groups and the criteria states:*
Star 3/4/5 Group A
Criteria: All junior high skaters in Star 3-5 (passed Star 3 Free Skate test or higher or equivalent of Preliminary Free Skate test or higher) And

Skaters in Grade 5 or higher who have passed Star 5 Test or equivalent of Junior Bronze Free Skate or higher.

Star 3/4/5 Group B
Criteria: Skaters up to and in Grade 6 who have passed Star 3 Free Skate test or higher or equivalent of Preliminary Free Skate test or higher.

Competitive
Criteria: -Must compete Pre-Juvenile or higher, or Star 7 or higher and competing 2 programs
-Priority will be given to those going to Sectionals
-Must be 5th session or higher
-If Competitive skaters meet Senior criteria they will skate on Senior sessions. If not they will skate on the appropriate Star 3/4/5 and Competitive sessions.
-Must be signed off by Coach
-Minimum of 2 off-ice sessions weekly and at least 1 has to be with the Club (proof of off-ice outside the club will be needed)
-1 off-ice jump session weekly is mandatory (attendance will be taken)
-Skater must meet the above criteria and if something changes throughout the season the skater can no longer avail of this session and refunds will be provided.
2. *No Skater will be allowed on the ice until all required documentation is signed [Parent Code of Conduct, Skater Code of Conduct, Club Policies & Release] and payment is received in **FULL**. If the required documentation is not received, registration will be deemed incomplete. The club accepts cash and/or cheque, (up to 7 equal payments on the 15th of each month; Sept 2017-Mar 2018)*
3. *No Private lessons will be allowed to take place while edges/turns/stroking or group spins is in progress.*
4. *All skaters will register where they fit based on criteria and space. All registration forms need to be signed by a base coach before registration can take place. This will ensure your skater is registered in the appropriate sessions.*
5. *For safety reasons, there are a maximum number of skaters allowed on the ice for each of the sessions. They are as follows:*
 - Canskate – 60 skaters
 - STAR 1/2 – 25 skaters; 30 skaters on group day
 - STAR 3/4/5 – 18 skaters
 - Senior – 16 skaters
 - Competitive - 15
 - Star 3/4/5 and Senior combined - 16
6. *Silver Blades SC reserves the right to re-allocate a skater to a more appropriate session to guarantee maximum use of ice time.*
7. *Silver Blades SC reserves the right to change the schedule depending on registration and also to accommodate special circumstances such as test sessions and emergency situations.*
8. *Schedule is subject to change, as programs may add ice time to certain days to avoid make-ups, as well as adjust to accommodate ice availability. All skaters pay an additional Skate Canada Fee of \$35.65 for the skating season. Registration is done on a **first-come, first-serve basis with registration for returning skates first**. Registering for a session in all three blocks will reserve a spot for that session.*

Refund Policy

- Refunds for the 2017-2018 skating season will only be made after **DAY ONE** of the skating block with a medical note for STAR 1/2 to Senior skaters, as well as Synchro skaters. These refunds will be subject to a \$25 administrative fee and there is no refund on the \$35.65 Skate Canada fee.
- CANSKATE PROGRAM EXCEPTION – a skater can receive full refund after one week ending on Friday of that week. These refunds will be subject to a \$25 administrative fee.
- COMPETITIVE SESSION EXCEPTION - If a competitive skater chooses to no longer skate competitively throughout the season they are unable to remain skating on the competitive sessions. Refunds will be calculated and issued once appropriate documentation is received. These refunds will be subject to a \$25 administrative fee.

- Refunds will be issued once all appropriate documentation is received.

Dear Parents:

The Silver Blades Skating Club is responsible for ensuring all skaters are safe when they are on the ice. When a skater's attention is diverted away from the ice, toward a parent who may be requesting the skater practice a particular jump or spin, for example, all skaters are placed in danger.

For this reason, and to ensure all Skate Canada rules and regulations are met, the Silver Blades Skating Club executive is asking you to refrain from coaching your child from the stands. We also request that you let the child's professional coach work with your child for the health and safety of all concerned.

The Silver Blades Skating Club offers its members the opportunity to practice the sport of figure skating in an environment that is safe for all skaters. To ensure our coaches are able to provide such an environment, the executive requests all parents and guardians adhere to the Skate Canada Parent Code of Conduct. The Skate Canada Parent Code of Conduct states in part:

- All parents are expected to conduct themselves in a responsible manner consistent with the values of fair play, integrity, open communication and mutual respect.
- Parents shall always model positive and responsible behaviour...Parents will assume the major responsibility for their son/daughter's on ice conduct and attitude.
- Parents shall at all times treat all individuals and property with dignity, courtesy and respect, including but not limited to skaters, coaches, officials, volunteers, other parents, and all other individuals that are part of the club, skating school, Section or Skate Canada.

Spending time at the rink gives a parent or guardian the opportunity to observe the interaction between coach and skater, as well as some idea of the aims and objectives set. Silver Blades Skating Club does understand the balance between being supportive and obtrusive can be difficult to judge and it is important that parents as well as skaters maintain a balanced approach to the sport.

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Silver Blades Skating Club 2017/18 Session Criteria

Session criteria can change yearly depending on a number of factors, including, skating numbers, ice time, age and skating level. All skaters registering with Silver Blades Skating Club Star 1 - Senior and Competitive will need their registration forms signed off by their base coach before registration can be completed.

Pre-Canskate and Canskate

Criteria: Must be 3 years of age or older and wanting to learn how to skate.

Star 1/2

Criteria: Skaters must have passed Canskate Stage 6

Star 3/4/5 Group A

Criteria: All junior high skaters in Star 3-5 (passed Star 3 Free Skate Test or higher or equivalent of Preliminary Free Skate test or higher)

And Skaters in Grade 5 or higher who have passed Star 5 Test or equivalent of Junior Bronze Free Skate or higher.

Star 3/4/5 Group B

Criteria: Skaters up to and in Grade 6 who have passed Star 3 Free Skate test or higher or equivalent of Preliminary Free Skate test or higher.

Senior

Criteria: -Senior, Star and Competitive skaters on these sessions must have a minimum of 14 points.

- Skills - 1 point per test passed
- Free Skate - 1 point per part passed (elements and/or free skate)
- Dances - 1 point per set of dances passed

Competitive

Criteria: -Must compete Pre-Juvenile or higher or Star 7 or higher and be competing 2 programs

- Priority will be given to those going to Sectionals
- Must be 5th session or higher
- If Competitive skaters meet Senior criteria they will skate on Senior sessions. If not they will skate on the appropriate Star 3/4/5 and Competitive sessions.
- Must be signed off by Coach
- Minimum of 2 off ice and at least 1 has to be with Cub (proof of off ice outside the club will be needed)
- 1 off ice jump session weekly is mandatory (attendance will be taken)
- Skater must meet the above criteria and if something changes throughout the season the skater can no longer avail of this session and refunds will be provided.
